

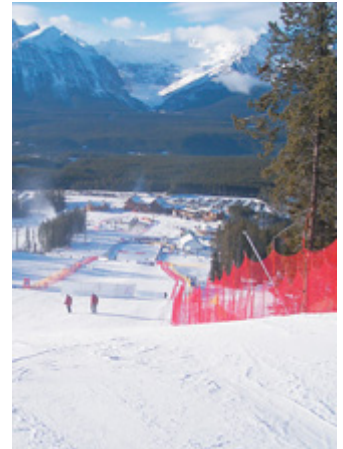
Why Choose the Barry B-Net System?

The installation instructions are continuously reviewed by Barry Cordage, and, where and when necessary, upgraded, and form part and parcel of the security of the system if installation is not effected in strict adherence to the instructions provided, the risk of injury to a skier may increase dramatically. Barry Cordage provides for the training of the personnel responsible for the installation of the BARRY B-NET SYSTEMS, and furthermore provides technical assistance on an ongoing basis including a web site and an emergency hot line.

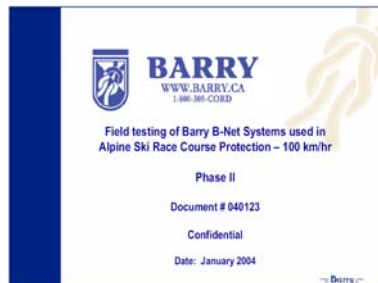
